TERMS & CONDITIONS

Cedar Garage Doors

Cedar is a natural product and although it is relatively stable the following can occur.

- Cupping and/or warping
- Splitting
- Board shrinkage (we check moisture content to ensure is below 15% at time of manufacture)
- Wider boards are more susceptible to the above problems

Due to cedar suppliers warranty these are not covered by Doors 2000 Warranty.

Colour Matching

Cedar is a natural product and therefore can be lines, knots and variations in colour and grains. We do our best to lay a uniform cedar door with boards supplied. The final look of the door can also change with the application of stain.

Staining / Painting of Cedar Doors

Staining or painting of Cedar Doors in dark colours is not recommended and will cause premature failing of the cedar cladding. North facing doors (increased exposure to sun) will be more vulnerable to this.

Colours with LRV (Light Reflective Value) of less than 50% are at owners risk.

We recommend the following oil penetrating stains :

CD50

Wattyl Forrestwood

Resene Woodsman

Doors must be sealed on the inside and outside and recoated on the outside annually, and every 6 months if north facing.

Customer Supplied Cedar

We can clad door frames with cedar supplied by customer but are not responsible for defects or moisture content in the material supplied. It must be provided to us in a raw state (no stain / paint applied).
